1. Is there a cost? No as it is funded by the Australian Government.
2. Is there a limit to the number of sessions? No, it is entirely up to you and the support you need, however the service is popular, so one-on-one support is up to a 1-hour session per month.
3. Is it just a chat? No, the first session is focussed on a stocktake of where you are at and taking the ideas out of your head and putting it into an action plan.
4. What happens in a session? Beyond the first stocktake session and getting to know you, we have Get Stuff Done sessions. This means that in the session we are working on tasks together and ticking things off your 'to do' list.
5. Is there a cost to the events, webinars and workshops? No as it is funded by the Australian Government.
6. This sounds too good to be true, what is the catch? There is no catch as the Australian Government is keen to see you create your own job, scale up and create employment for others.
